

# BEAVER COEXISTENCE TOOLS

## Materials & Suppliers

### CULVERT PROTECTOR MATERIALS

(Culvert protector must be a minimum of 8' out from the culvert, at an angle)

- ☐ Five sheets of 4'x8' (galvanized) wire mesh with 6"x6" mesh opening (6 gauge) OR Two 16' (13 line) hog panels  
*\*Mesh openings no larger than 6"x8", 24' total length of mesh*
- ☐ Four to six 7' steel T-posts
- ☐ One 50' roll galvanized wire (11-12 gauge)
- ☐ ~100 Hog rings (HLG3 # 3's)
- ☐ Eight pressure treated 2"x4" lumber
- ☐ 2.5" deck screws



### POND LEVELLER MATERIALS

- ☐ Three sheets of 4'x8' (galvanized) wire mesh with 6"x6" mesh opening (6 gauge)  
*\*Mesh openings no larger than 6"x8", 24' total length of mesh*
- ☐ Four 7' steel T-posts
- ☐ One 50' roll galvanized wire (11-12 gauge)
- ☐ ~100 Hog rings (HLG3 # 3's)
- ☐ 40' double-walled poly pipe (25-40% capacity of downstream drainage) (ex. downstream 36" diameter culvert = 12" double-walled pipe in upstream dam)
- ☐ One split coupler (same diameter as pipe)
- ☐ ~2 extra zip ties for coupler
- ☐ ~Nine 2" deck screws
- ☐ Two half cinder blocks or other water-safe weights

### Power Tools:

- ☐ Skill saw
- ☐ Cordless drill
- ☐ Reciprocating saw (optional for culvert protector)

### Non-power Tools:

- ☐ Hog ring pliers
- ☐ Regular or fencing pliers
- ☐ Wire cutters or side cutters
- ☐ Bolt cutters
- ☐ Post pounder or sledge hammer
- ☐ Tape measure
- ☐ Waders or rubber boots
- ☐ Dam clearing tools (rake, shovel etc.)
- ☐ Devices to help float pond leveller cage into place (e.g. plywood with two tire inner tubes, pool noodles); depending on depth a canoe or flat bottom boat is useful
- ☐ Appropriate safety gear (gloves, safety goggles, life jackets, etc.)
